Sir,

I have the honour to report that the following 10 individuals were arrested this morning under section 3(1) of Ordinance No. II of 1932 by the District Superintendent of Police and his Subordinates Police Officers :--

2. These individuals are prominent and extreme political agitators in the District who, if kept at large, are bound to act in a manner prejudicial to the public safety or peace. I would, therefore, urge Government to be good enough to detain them in custody for the full period of two months. Before the expiry of the period of these two months I shall take steps under section 4 of the said Ordinance to restrict their movements and regulate their manner of living.

3. I have now committed all these persons to the jail custody at Yeravada.



4. Three more persons noted in the List accompanying your No. S.D. 4111 H. D. (Special) of 24th December 1932, have not yet been traced. Enquiries about their whereabouts are in progress. No. 4 does not appear in the List but as he was found to cause some great disturbance, by the District Superintendent of Police he has been arrested. He is no doubt an active Congress agitator.

(Dear Mr. Hiremath,)

Reference your letter No. D/15 of 23rd January. From paragraph 1 of the letter it would appear that your warrant of remand in the case of Nana Ramchandra Patil was to the effect that he should be detained in the Yeravda Central Prison pending further orders from Government. If this presumption is correct, I am to ask you to note for future guidance that when you commit a person to jail custody under section 3(2) of the Emergency Powers Ordinance you should specify a period of detention in such custody not exceeding fifteen days. You can then, if necessary, apply to Government for extension of the period up to the limit of two months. An Order extending the period of detention of the person named above is being issued separately.

S.D.4111 dated 24/12/31 and the only one of those persons who was not so arrested, was arrested by the Nasik Police on the 9th instant and has since been convicted (under what law has not been reported to me) and sentenced to 6 months' rigorous imprisonment. In these circumstances I presume that it is not now necessary for me to take any further action against him.
