I have to thank your Highness for your letter of the 4th inst. enclosing a copy of the suggestions you have sent to Mr. Wood, in connection with the Ruling Chiefs Conference. Your Highness' suggestion about a Political Tribunal is sound and I agree with your opinion in demanding such an independent court for all political questions. I should however suggest

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that the personnel composing the Tribunal
and how they are nominated are
matters which require mature consideration

These and other details may
be settled with care and thought, hereafter.
They require a systematic handling and
that is really needed and likely to
achieve the end is continuous and sustained
effort on the part of many of our Rulers
and not spasmodic effort.
