Your despatch dated
the 12.th Instant relative to the
origin of the Insurrection in
Chota Nagpore was received
(बिहार सरकार अति उत्तम विदेशी)
on the 18.th and has been laid
before the Honorable the
President in Council.

2. His Honor in Council
refrains from expressing any
decided opinion as to the cause
of these disturbances, till cir-
cumstances may have had
time more fully to develop them-
selves and till you may be
able to afford him more precise
information.

^{their} conduct has indicated hostility
towards the Rajah, or only
such feelings as may be sup-
posed to be connived at by
him.

5. By the orders of Go-
vernment dated September 7th
1826 the Tax on the species
of Liquor denominated *Han-
deek* was abolished, whenever
it was prepared by Indivi-
duals in their own Houses
and solely for private con-
sumption. (बिहार राज्य के माल खास मालखाना)
It is now how-
ever stated to be again col-
lected, and a Tax to be le-
vied on each House in which
the Liquor is manufactured.
You are requested to explain
by whose authority the Tax
has been re-imposed, and
what you consider to have
been the effect of that measure
apart from the consideration
of

of the mode in which the ob-
jections have been made.

6. You are requested to
ascertain and report the names
and condition of all the per-
sons of Chief note whether
Jagheers or others who
have fallen a sacrifice to the
Insurgents or have suffered
much loss or injury in the In-
surrection, especially those
whose persons or property
were the first objects of their
revenge.

7. You have failed to
explain why the Police Officers
in the Southern part of Nag-
pore were silent as to the
cause of the disturbances
when they first reported
their commencement. You
are requested to supply this
omission

omission as far as you may
be able.

8. Your letters dated
the 14.th 15.th and 19.th Instant
have been received, and do
not appear to call for any
particular notice on the
present occasion.
