W. R. Forster, Officiating Commissioner of Sumbulpore, to W. S. Seton-Karr, Esq., omciating Secretary to the Government of Bengal,—(No. 146, dated 3rd December 1860.)

SIR,

I have to intimate to you, for the information of His Honor the Lieutenant-Governor, that Lieutenant J. D. Vallance, whom, after the dispersion of the Rebels from the Manikgurh Hills, I had directed to continue for a while with a party of Sebundies in the Khurriar District, for the purpose of aiding the Rajah in locating Thannahs of his Paiks at proper points, reports, in a letter dated Teekaparah 22nd November 1860, that the Rebel Zemindar, Lal Sah of Tahnoot, gave himself up to the Khurriar Rajah, who sent him in to Lieutenant Vallance's Camp. The conditions on which I proposed some time ago to extend pardon to Lal Sah was, that he should exert himself and deliver up the other leaders of Insurgents, viz. Soorundur Sai, Koonjul Sing, and Gobind Sing, who are implicated in murder and plunder in the Raipore District.
