From our Abstracts and recent report on affairs at Deogarh it will have been noticed that the name of Manindra Nath Basu, No. 10 in our list of suspects, has been frequently mentioned.

This man has been known to us as a suspicious character for quite a long time but so far we have not been able to gather sufficient evidence on which we could proceed against him.

Since the arrest of such notorious characters as Ananta Halder, Bhaba Bhushan Mitra and Santi Kumar Bakshi with all of whom he was friendly, Mani Basu is the only source of real trouble left at Deogarh. So long as he is there it will always be possible to make this place a harbour for suspects from Bengal and a rendezvous for suspicious characters.

During a recent visit I paid to Durna to discuss the general situation of the district, Mr. Perrott gave it as his opinion that this man was the centre of attraction for disloyal persons coming to Deogarh.

Though we have sufficient grounds now to justify action against Manindra Nath Basu I consider that it would be more expedient perhaps to instruct the Special Branch Officer at Deogarh to keep a very strict watch over the movements, doings and associates of this man and if anything fresh comes to our notice, within a

dated the 9th. November, 1916.

A few days ago Rai Bahadur Bansidhar Banarji, C.I.E. who was staying here invited some people of the town to dine at his house. Babu Khitish Chandra Sen, Sub-Deputy Magistrate was one of the guests he passed disparaging remarks against me and the local Deputy Superintendent and said that the C.I.D. has got various highly paid agents here. Books from Moni Basu's house are found in his house and I think he is in touch with Moni Basu through some body.
