In pursuance of the orders contained in rule 14 of Schedule 1 to the Regulations for the nomination and election of Additional Members of the Legislative Council of the Lieutenant-Governor of Bihar and Orissa, I have the honour to report that Rai Sudam Charan Naik Bahadur, of Ganga Mandir, town Cuttack, is duly elected to be a member of the said Council by the Commissioners of the Municipalities of Cuttack, Jajpur, Kendrapara, Balasore, Puri and Sambalpur which have been notified under order of the Government notification No. 5078A of the 22nd November 1912. Rai Sudam Charan Naik Bahadur secured 14 votes out of the total number of 16 votes assigned to these Municipalities under order V of the aforesaid notification.

2. I beg to request that the name of Rai Sudam Charan Naik Bahadur may be published accordingly as a member of the Legislative Council of the Lieutenant-Governor of Bihar and Orissa in the Local Official Gazette as required under the rule referred to above.
