By the orders contained in paragraph 12 of the Home Department Resolution Nos. 1273—1290, dated the 8th September 1904, the Sanitary Commissioner with the Government of India was empowered to correspond unofficially with the Provincial Sanitary Commissioners and the Heads of Provincial Laboratories regarding matters of departmental procedure, forms and statistics, and purely technical questions. Experience has shown that the restriction to unofficial correspondence of the Sanitary Commissioner's references to the officers named has produced considerable inconvenience, and I am directed to state that the Governor-General in Council is pleased to direct that these references may in future be made officially.
