It is not known when exactly the ban was imposed but direct-ives have been issued on the subject from time to time. The attached copy of D.P.R's u.o. No.7127/1/PR(g) dated 24.8.45 on this subject may please be seen in this connexion.

1. The following standing instruction in "Press Censorship Instructions - India" is still included in the latest issue, dated 1st April 1945. It applies to Press messages entering or leaving India.

"Stop all messages mentioning the employment by the Japanese of regular or irregular forces comprised of Indians, or to any form of Provisional Government of Indians set up by the Japanese in occupied territory."

This stop was partially lifted on 10th May of this year and a Press Note was issued revealing certain facts about the I.N.A.

In June, as a result of discussions between C.P.A.C.M.P.C. and the Chief Press Censor, S.A.C.S.E.A., the following "Special Stops" were issued, and they are still in operation. These Special Stops are part of "Press Censorship Instructions - India".

- Stop any story in which an attempt is made to justify the action of individuals in joining the I.N.A. or their activities while members of it. (a)
- Refer any story concerning the I.N.A. movements which shows a tendency towards exaggeration or which if published would have an adverse effect on the army. (b)
- Refer all messages quoting statements by Subhas Chandra Bose and any reference to present or future activity of the I.N.A. and the Provisional Government of Free India. (c)

On 29th July a special guidance to Press Censors at Bombay and Calcutta was issued, and C.P.A. was requested to endeavour to comply with it.

"Refer to Press Room any discussion of projected legal proceedings in connection with the I:N.A.
