

BUNG I

British bun chhung (1890 – 1947) Chanchin tlêm :

Mizovin mi lulâk an chin laia, an vel hnam dangte leh Cachar thingpui huante an rawk fo kha huain, British Sorkârin phuba la tûrin sipaite an tîr thin a. 1850 kumin Col. Lister-in Sentlâng a hâl a; 1864 kum khân Capt. Lewin (Mizovin ‘Thangliana’ an tih thin) Chittagong lam atangin a lo chho va, 1869-ah Brigadier General Nuthal leh Pu Edgar (Cachar D.C.) an lo lût bawk a; 1871—72 (Mizovin “Vailen hmasa” an ti thin) kum khân Gen. Brownlow leh Capt. Lewin, Chittagong D.C. chhim lam atangin an lo lût a; Gen. Bourchier leh Pu Edgar, Cachar D.C. ten hmâr lam an nawr a, Champhai an thleng hial a. Tin, 1888 kum khân Col. Tregeear hovin an lo lut leh a. Chu chu Mizovin “Vai len hnuhnûng” an tih kha a ni. 1890-ah Mizo ram chu British-in a la nghet ta a. Lunglei-ah Capt. J. Shakespeare (Tarmita) a thu a, Aijal-ah Capt. Browne Bawrhsâp angin a thu bawk a. Indo lam chanchin ziak mi leh hla phuah thiam hmingthang Rûdyard Kipling pawhin 1890 khân hetiang hian hla a phuah hial a—

“Afridiman mite kan phindarh ang khân,
Naga leh Lusei-ho pawh kan tu tlâwm ta.” tiin.

1898 kum khân Zoram Chhim leh Umâr, a hrâne ve ve a Bengal leh Assam Sorkâr ukawl thin chu Assam Chief Commissioner hnuâa dah a lo ni tu a.

Tin, 1919 kuma India Sorkâr Dân siam angin ram awpna chungchâng rêng rêng chu Assam Chief Commissioner ni ta lovin Assam Governor leh a Council te hnênah hlan a ni ta zawk a. 1935 kuma India Sorkâr Dân thupék angin Mizo ram chu "Excluded Area" a chhiar tel a ni a. Tichuan, British Parliament mawhphurhna chu India Viceroy kutah hlan a ni nghâl a, anin Assam Governor hnênah a hlan chhâwng a. Zoram pumpuia hmasâwnna leh inawpna a lo fel zawk theih nân dàn tam tak siam than a lo ni a. Tin, khaw tin inawpna a fel zawk theih nân ramri siam fel a nih bâkah tiâng changtu atân lal fapa upa ber ruat a ni a, fapa naupang ber erawhechu ro khâwintu atân. Tiâng changtu tûr ful fapa upa ber te lehkha zir nân Sorkârin châwmra a pe a.

Ram hmasâwnna lam ngaihtuah tûrin department hrang hrang, P.W.D., Agriculture, Medical, Forest, Postal, Veterinary leh Education te siam a ni a. An chanchin chiang zâwkin kan la thlir ang.

Tin, khatia ramhuai leh thlarau hlauva phi cuai thin kha Kristian an lo ni a, inthawi fo leh thi mak deuh apiang hlau khân thlamuanna naminlo an lo nei ta a.


